Application Procedure. The application deadline is May 1, 2018; if not filled, then every two weeks thereafter until the search is closed in May 2019. Applications received in this pool will be used during academic year 2018-2019. Formal application must be accomplished through submission of a 1) video, no more than 3 minutes, that addresses how you meet the qualifications and details on your teaching agenda, 2) resume or CV, 3) teaching statement including philosophy, platform stacks and programming languages proficiency, 4) evidence of teaching competency/teaching evaluations, 5) list of ASU CIS [courses](#) that you are interested in teaching, and 6) list of references all uploaded through <http://apply.interfolio.com/48970>.
